ON THE TOUR This is a shuttle tour, but you will be walking & standing during the tour too

Best for guests who want to cruise through a beautiful farm while learning about breeding and raising young Thoroughbreds, not just in Kentucky but around the world.

Gainsborough Farm is a nursery division of Godolphin, the international thoroughbred breeding and racing operation founded by HH Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Ruler of Dubai.

To begin the tour, you will learn about the history of Gainsborough Farm as well as the global scope of HH Sheikh Mohammed's international thoroughbred operations. From there you will climb aboard an electric shuttle for a scenic drive through the farm with stops along the way to meet our broodmares and learn about their racing and breeding careers. These mares love to pose for photos and meet new people! Depending on the time of year, you will also get to meet new foals, weanlings, and/or yearlings.

Among the mares that guests may see on a visit to Gainsborough Farm are Breeders' Cup champions ROUND POND and ASHADO, as well as DANCE CARD (dam of Cody's Wish), DELIGHTFUL QUALITY (dam of Essential Quality) and VELVETY (dam of Maxfield). This is a wonderful opportunity for guests who want to meet superstar mares!



WHAT YOU'LL SEE World-Class Equine Veterinary Care

BEST FOR Ages 10+

ON THE TOUR You will be walking & standing throughout the tour

Best for guests wanting a behind-the-scenes look into equine veterinary medicine, highlighting care & commitment for the horse. A must see for horse lovers!

Regardless of their competitive discipline and lifestyle, all horses deserve the same worldclass equine veterinary care. From assistance delivering a foal in the field to the most precise medical attention at the main-campus facility, they have provided the best care possible for nearly 150 years.

Centrally located in the heart of Horse Country, the practices' state-of-the-art facility sits on over IIO acres and is directly across from the Kentucky Horse Park. The walking tour, lasting an hour and a half long, guides you through Hagyard's history and the day-to-day operations of a fully functioning equine hospital including the Davidson Surgery Center and McGee Medicine Center.

Due to the potential graphic and sensitive nature of live surgery and medical procedures, this tour is not suitable for children under the age of 10 years old. This limitation is in place to protect staff, horses and guests. This is a one-mile walking tour of the Hagyard campus. Please wear appropriate footwear for walking long stretches of time. As an operating veterinary hospital. Emergency situations may arise that limit areas of the hospital that can be seen.



WHAT YOU'LL SEE Stallions, you may take pictures, but this is a hands-off tour

BEST FOR All Ages, curious, casual, and committed fans welcome

ON THE TOUR There is ample walking & standing throughout the tour

Best for guests who want to learn more about the stallion business of the global Thoroughbred industry and those looking to see some of the biggest names in horse racing history.

Come visit the stallion complex at Jonabell Farm in Lexington, Kentucky, and learn all about the thoroughbred breeding business! Jonabell is the American headquarters for the <u>Godolphin</u> thoroughbred breeding and racing operation and is the home of the <u>Darley</u> stallions in America.

The tour begins at the farm office where you will visit the trophy room and learn about the history of Jonabell as well as the global scope of HH Sheikh Mohammed's international thoroughbred operations. The tour will then head outside for a walking tour of the stallion complex to see the champion stallions in their paddocks (please wear comfortable shoes!). You will learn about the stallions' race careers, progeny and daily routines while viewing the horses enjoying their time outside. The tour will also walk through the breeding shed and visit the gravesite of 1978 Triple Crown winner AFFIRMED.

Among the stallions that guests may see on a visit to Jonabell Farm are two-time Breeders' Cup winner and Horse of the Year CODY'S WISH, Kentucky Derby winners NYQUIST and STREET SENSE, Belmont Stakes winner ESSENTIAL QUALITY, multiple GI winners FROSTED and MAXFIELD, and perennial leading sire MEDAGLIA D'ORO.

WHAT YOU'LL SEE Keeneland's hallowed grounds and morning training

ON THE TOUR You will be outside walking & standing throughout the tour

Best for guests who want to know more about Keeneland and Thoroughbred horse racing, suited for those new to racing, racing enthusiasts and anywhere in between!

Get an up-close look at this National Historic Landmark on a tour of Keeneland. On this outside walking tour, your experienced tour guide will take you through the Keeneland paddock and grandstand, grounds, and when available, to the world-renowned Keeneland Sales Pavilion.

You'll learn more about this pillar of the equine industry in Kentucky, and will likely see horses training on the track.

WHAT YOU'LL SEE Adoptable horses of all breeds, you may get hands-on too!

BEST FOR All Ages + Kid-Friendly, horse lovers & newbies welcome

ON THE TOUR You will be walking & standing throughout the tour

Best for guests who want to get up close and personal with horses looking for new homes. Learn about equine care, rehabilitation and retraining on this experience.

Get up close and personal with the residents of Kentucky's only all-breed equine rescue, and see what we do to give horses a fresh start on a new chapter in their lives!

The tour begins by the brick garage, where we give an overview of the farm, then we'll walk around the barn and visit horses in the fields and hear their stories. You will see a demonstration of training that takes place in our arena or round pen, come back through the barn where you learn about some rehabilitation successes, and might see a veterinary exam, foot treatment, acupuncture, or other example of care (not guaranteed, according to the schedule of individual horses). We'll conclude with an opportunity for you to feed a horse or pony a treat and interact with them.



WHAT YOU'LL SEE Mares & Foals + Yearlings + two Stallions, you may get hands-on too!

BEST FOR All Ages, curious, casual, and committed fans welcome

ON THE TOUR There is outside walking & standing throughout the tour

Best for guests who want to touch a horse, are enthusiastic about carrots and want a well-rounded horse farm tour where they can learn more about the Thoroughbred business.

PLEASE NOTE: This tour requires guests to arrive and drive in their own vehicles. No Motorcycles or Rideshare options i.e., Uber, Lyft or Public Taxi Services are unfortunately not allowed.

The tour kicks off in the breeding shed where you will gain an understanding of why this land is so uniquely suited for the Thoroughbred and learn the history of the Headley family and their involvement in the industry.

From there, you will hop in your vehicles and follow the tour guide around the farm in a caravan. The group will then stop at different locations around the farm to interact with horses of varying ages. You'll be able to get up close and personal with friendly equine residents, and even feed them carrots! The tour ends back in the breeding shed with our resident stallions, OSCAR PERFORMANCE, Breeders Cup Juvenile Turf winner with racetrack earnings over \$2.3 million and who currently holds the world record for the fastest mile on the turf and our newest stallion, ALOHA WEST, Breeders Cup Sprint winner with earnings on the racetrack over \$1.5 million.


WHAT YOU'LL SEE Thoroughbreds in retraining, you may get hands-on too!

The tour will visit the historic stallion complex and state-of-the-art dual breeding shed, unlike any other in the Bluegrass, where more than 3,000 mares walk through its doors during any given breeding season. You will view a selection of the Spendthrift Farm stallions, while learning about their race record, pedigree and progeny, before walking through the rest of the stallion barn to see the many champions that call Spendthrift home.

Throughout the tour, you will learn about Spendthrift's colorful founder, the larger than life Leslie Combs, who was known for both entertaining celebrity guests and revolutionizing the thoroughbred industry. You will also hear more on industry innovator B. Wayne Hughes, who has not only revitalized Spendthrift Farm but invested in the sport of horse racing for years to come.

On this shuttle tour, you will be given the opportunity to explore the different facets of Spy Coast Farm and learn how they have grown to be a major player in the show jumping community.

You will tour the state-of-the-art Rehabilitation and Fitness Center, Stallion Barn, CEM Quarantine, Young Horse Development Center, Equine Education Center, and Reproduction Center where our mares and foals reside. Touring these facilities provides a great opportunity to learn about show jumping and how horse management, training, and care differs from other equine industries.

This walking tour of Stonestreet Farm will take you through their barns and farm to show you up close and personal their operation. You will learn their history and stories of the mares' successes both on the track and as a mother. Depending on the time of year you will see different cycles of a thoroughbred's life (spring/summer you will see mares & foals and in the fall you will see mares & weanlings).

Our program prides itself on letting horses exist as nature intended; mares and foals spend the majority of their day outside in our large paddocks where the rolling hills strengthen bone and build muscle. You will be able to see their horses up close and personal!
